Khwaja Enayetpuri (R)

Khwaja Enayetpuri Tariqa, one of the largest Sufi Orders in Bangladesh established by Shah Sufi Hazrat Mawlana Khwaja Yunus Ali, popularly known as Khwaja Enayetpuri (R) in the 20th century.

This Khaniqah located at Enayetpur in the district of Sirajgonj represents mostly Muzaddediya Tariqah though influenced by other Turuq (Orders)—Naqsh bandiya, Al-Qadiri, and Al-Chishti.

The widely renowned Sufi saint Khwaja Enayetpuri of Enayetpur_Darbar Sharif is the most successful and celebrated Sheikh in Bangladesh and Assam in India. Not only did he teach thousands of followers but he also guided some successful spiritual leaders who have/had set up different Khaniqahs in different places of the country. Some large ones are Biswa Zaker Manzil (World Zaker Centre) at Atrasi in Faridpur, Shambhuganj Darbar Sharif, Paradise para Darbar Sharif, Murshidpur Darbar Sharif, Chandrapara Darbar Sharif, to name a few.

Needless to say, so recognized and so venerated is this Enayetpur Darbar Sharif that almost all classes of people from the highest rank to the poor day laborer visit it to vow to Allah (SWT) against all sinful attachments to the world. His teachings are highly venerated and embraced by hundreds of thousands of people in this sub-continent. The Enayetpur Tariqa has drawn wide attention of the Western people.



Honorable Founder of Khwaja Yunus Ali University



Dr. Mir Mohammad Amjad Hussain
(1st October 1925 - 11th September 2012)

Dr. M. M. Amjad Hussain, an entrepreneur with a most benevolent and compassionate personality was born on 01 October 1925 in Enayetpur in the district of Sirajganj. He had his primary education in a local Madrasha in his village. He completed his secondary education at the Sthal Pakrashi Uchcha Biddyalay (High school). After successfully passing the Matriculation Examination in 1941, he got himself admitted into Rajshahi College and obtained his Intermediate of Science Certificate in 1943. He then went to Kolkata and successfully enrolled himself into Kolkata Medical College to study medicine. He graduated in medicine in 1948. Having been awarded the degree of Bachelor of Medicine, he joined the Pakistan Army in its Medical Corps in 1952.

After serving the Army for three years, he took self-retirement and turned out to be an entrepreneur. He started with an export oriented industry named Bangladesh Kapok Mills Limited in 1955 in Chittagong. Soon after, he established Alhaj Textile Mills Limited at Ishwardi in 1962, Alhaj Jute Mills in 1967 at Sharishabari, Jamalpur. He was uncontested Chairman of the Bangladesh Textile Mills Association for many years. In 1982, he established a pharmaceutical company named Drug International Limited. The Advanced Technology and Ideas Ltd. (ATI), an IT firm was founded in 1994. In 1997, Drug International Basic Chemicals Division was set up. Afterwards, ATI Ceramics Ltd was launched in 2004 to manufacture floor and wall tiles. In addition, he became interested towards contributing to the development of tea industry in Bangladesh and later, established M. M. Tea Estate Ltd. in Panchagarh. M. M. Multi Fibers Ltd was then founded in 2006. Because of his being an entrepreneur of the group of companies and at the same time as one of the highest tax payers, he was nominated as Commercially Important Person (CIP) by the Ministry of Industries of the Bangladesh Government.



Besides being a pioneering entrepreneur in many fields of trade and business, Dr. M. M. Amjad Hussain concentrated towards helping the deprived community of society. Realizing the importance and urgency of women's empowerment, he thought of creating opportunities for women's education and he established a girls' school, Meher-Un-Nesa Uchchya Balika Biddyalay in Enayetpur. In order to provide the much needed health facilities to the poor people of Bangladesh, he established a 500 bed hospital as a non-trading concern in Enayetpur by the name of his spiritual leader, a Muslim Saint Hazrat Khwaja Yunus Ali (R) on 124 acres of land which is managed by specialist doctors, trained nurses along with utilization of modern equipment. The hospital is capable of providing healthcare of Treatment of all kind of diseases. In 2005, Khwaja Yunus Ali Medical College was founded to produce medical graduates at a private institution level that was able to draw students from home and abroad. Besides the Medical College, a Nursing College was established to produce skilled manpower for the demanding profession of the nursing.

The Khwaja Yunus Ali Laboratory School and college was brought into existence to facilitate children's education of those living inside the campus and the general public living in the villages adjacent to it. The school is functioning with the national curricula of English version. Dr. M. M. Amjad Hussain did not stop his endeavor for uplifting the fate of his fellow countrymen until he could complete founding Khwaja Yunus Ali University.

This extra ordinarily brilliant, disciplined, educated, honest, and patriotic person passed away on 11 September, 2012. May Allah bless his soul with eternal peace in Jannah!

Health Care Services:

The University runs a day-Clinic with medically qualified officer within the building. Health Care services are also provided with by the nearby Khwaja Yunus Ali Medical College and Hospital. The staff and students enjoy the medical facilities of the world class 500 bedded Hospital. The students get free consultation. They are provided with free bed when admitted. The staff members are entitled for 20% discount on investigations charges and total hospital expenditure.

Scholarships and Waiver:

Since its inception, KYAU has been awarding merit scholarships and financial assistances to deserving students. Waivers are given from a minimum of 10% to 100% in some cases.

Residential Halls for Students

- a) Male Hall `Jamuna', a 4 storied building is located just in front of the main gate of the University. The Hall has got a capacity of accommodating 256 students'.
- b) Female Dormitory: Female students' dormitory with 256 student's capacity is located in a high security Zone area within Khwaja Yunus Ali Medical College and Hospital compound.

Accreditation and Collaboration

Khwaja Yunus Ali University (KYAU) is accredited by the Ministry of Education, Government of the Peoples' Republic of Bangladesh. All the programs it currently offers and the Course curricula have been approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of Bangladesh, the only national accreditation authority in Bangladesh. The Honorable President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh is the Chancellor of Khwaja Yunus Ali University. To be at par with the exponential development of technology in the 21st Century Khwaja Yunus Ali University signed a collaboration Program with EU₄ consortium and is now known as the 6th member for conducting Master's Program in Mechatronics and micro-mechatronics System Engineering, in addition to other science based courses.

The other members of the Consortium are University of Oviedo, Spain, University Karlsruhe, Germany, University of Paris, The University of Russia and The Nile University, Egypt. Under the exchange programs, the students of KYAU can transfer their credits to foreign Universities; faculties can exchange research work and share experiences. Khwaja



Yunus Ali University is also the member of the Association of Private University of Bangladesh (APUB).

If a student becomes sick during his/her academic tenure, s/he can avail a unique opportunities of treatment facilities from the ultra-modern, tertiary leveled Khwaja Yunus Ali Medical College & Hospital which is located adjacent to Khwaja Yunus Ali University campus.

For students, the University is dedicated to provide 25% discount of all types of diagnostic tests related cost. or Those who need to be hospitalized are granted with full free bed in the hospital. In addition, the hospital offers all time medical services and pathological tests for the faculty members, administrative officials and staffs at affordable cost. Waivers in these cases are provided according to the University's policy.

Library:

The Library of KYAU is the “heart” of this institution and serving as an important academic resource for students and faculties. Since its inception in 2012, KYAU has been taking over all possible steps to build a well-equipped modern Library. Khwaja Yunus Ali University library has an inbuilt open access system to facilitate the library users to have easy right of entry to the library resources. KYAU library is an integral part of the university and designed to meet the information, research and curricular demands of its students, faculties, researchers and staff members. The ‘Freedom Fight Corner’ and the ‘Sufism Corner’ are the two Corner Stores of our Library attracting readers.

KYAU library is going to run through a fully automated system, the “KOHA Integrated Library Management System” and “Greenstone Digital Library Software”, and it also offers a full range of information and enquiry services with the help of modern techniques and technologies. The library’s purpose is to enrich teaching, learning and research endeavors of the university by delivering easy access to relevant information resources and providing quality services and facilities. At present, KYAU library is procuring books of various important and essential titles, relevant academic reports and national & international journals and required audio-visual materials.

In addition to these collections, the library subscribes local magazines & leading national newspapers of Bangladesh. The Library also organizes orientation programmes at every semester for the new students to demonstrate how to use the university library system & service effectively. Regarding membership issue, all students, faculty members, part-time faculty members, teaching assistants, research assistants and officers are entitled to become the library member. To get membership of the library



one should provide 1(One) copy of passport size photograph and 1 (One) copy of stamp size photograph. The person will have to fill up the library membership form.

Laboratory:

The University has its own laboratories for the Departments of Biochemistry & Biotechnology, Microbiology, Pharmacy, Textile Engineering, Medical Physics, Computer Science & Engineering (CSE), Electrical & Electronic Engineering (EEE), and Management Information System (MIS) and the proposed Mechatronics & Micro Mechatronics Engineering.

The laboratories of each department are fully supported by university to ensure research-based learning of the students. Each laboratory is equipped with sophisticated research-based instruments ensuring state-of-the-art facilities for doing practical and research work for our students and faculty members

High Speed Internet Facilities:

The University provides high-speed Internet access (Broadband & Wi-Fi) in different places of the campus that include administrative building, central and Teachers' Cafeteria, Library, students' residence Halls, Faculty residence area and all parts of the campus.

The Library provides stations for connecting users' laptops to local area networks (LANs). Students, faculty members, and staffs use high-speed internet in the campus free of charge. The high speed internet facilities are helping students tremendously, particularly in gathering their academic resources through online.

Fully Equipped Laboratories:

At present we have substantial resources in its physical and Electronic infrastructural facilities. We have more than 10 well-equipped laboratories under the faculty of Biomedical Science and the faculty of Science and Engineering and they are equipped with necessary instruments. The Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering has its own spacious laboratory. The computer Science Engineering laboratory has its own laboratory equipped with required no. of computers so also the Department of Management information system Departments. The Department of English has an Audio-Visual laboratory for conducting language classes. The Department of pharmacy has four laboratories and animal House and large field of medicinal plants of their own The IT section is equipped with the latest versions of hardware and software facilities having modern servers.



Modern Computer Lab:

The university has a modern central computer lab providing computing and Internet facilities to the students and faculty members/officers. The laboratory is maintained by experienced teachers and equipped with sufficient numbers of computers so that each of the students can use one computer to follow the lecture. Each computer is connected with LAN and installed with many required technical and educational software. The computer lab has served over the years as the hub for computer related services in the campus.

It has a unique position in providing computing and network facilities to the campus to serve the University for all its IT requirements. Our students use this lab not only for tech-learning but also for virtual travelling in the Universities across the globe. We train and motivate our students to use this lab as a tool to learn about world's renowned Universities, their admission requirements, application systems, and things what are constantly happening in the rapidly changing world.

Being paralleled to our English Language Club, the lab also serves as a great channel in preparing our students for GRE, TOEFL, IELTS and other English proficiency tests required for their next trip to study abroad. Now our current plan is to expand the optical backbone network to students' halls and teachers' residential area with the availability of secured access of the academic and research materials very soon.

Application:

A student can apply either through our online application system or by collecting our paper-based admission form from Admission Office. Attested photocopies of all certificates, mark sheets, testimonials, 2 passport size photographs are required to be submitted with the admission form. For online application, students have to go to the admission page in our website (<http://www.kyau.edu.bd>) and click the link- apply here Undergraduate Program, Graduate Program. At the time of taking admission, selected candidates are required to show their original Certificates, Mark sheets/ Transcripts, Testimonials and submit 1 (one) copy of stamp-size photograph.

Application steps

Collect the prescribed application form from the Front desk (Reception) or Admission office of Khwaja Yunus Ali University (KYAU), Enayetpur, Sirajgonj or from our Head Office located at the 'Khwaja Enayetpuri Tower', 17, Green Road, Dhaka and fill it up properly as specified therein. The application form is also available in our website (link of PDF) Submit the application form to our admission office along with Taka 300/- or a bank draft of equivalent amount as well as your academic documents. The documents to be attached as directed overleaf of the application form.

We review all the applications for admission. Incomplete applications will not be entertained for evaluation. After reviewing, all the eligible candidates will be notified by our admission office for admission. In some cases, admission test may be taken to make sure the students' program specific competencies.

Selected candidates will then be required to collect the 'Registration Request Form' (RRF) from the respective Heads of the Departments in which s/he wants to get enrolled. Departmental Heads will assign the appropriate semester, required courses and credit numbers to those candidates.

Candidates need to collect the 'pay-in-slip' from the admission office by submitting the RRF form. The Slip has 4 parts: two for office copy, one for Bank copy and the remaining one is for the student.

The 'pay-in-slip' should be appropriately filled in for submission to the admission office. Our concerned officials will mention the amount relating to the fees of admission, tuition, libraries, computer lab, laboratory, etc.

The 'pay-in-slip' duly filled in by the student concerned will be accompanied by an office staff to the Trust Bank, KYAMCH Branch to deposit the money. The Bank is situated in the same campus.



On payment of the fees, the payment slips returned by the bank should again be submitted to the admission office again.

The student you will then receive a copy from the admission office confirming enrollment of the student (s) to her/his desired programme. On completion of the enrollment, students are required to contact the respective academic advisors.

Undergraduate Admission Requirements:

A candidate must fulfill any of the following requirements for admission to an undergraduate program at the KYAU:

- I. S/he must have at least 2nd division or a minimum GPA of 2.5 or an equivalent grade separately in SSC and HSC or equivalent public examinations. However, if the candidate has a minimum GPA of 2.0 in either of these examinations, his/her cumulative GPA of the two examinations must be at least 6.0.
- II. S/he must have passed at least 5 subjects in the O-Level and at least 2 subjects in the A-Level examinations. In these two examinations, the candidate must have a minimum GPA of 4.0 or grade 'B' in 4 of the 7 subjects and a GPA of at least 3.5 or grade 'C' in the rest.
- III. A ward of freedom fighter (s) will be considered eligible for admission if s/he has a total GPA of 5.0 in SSC and HSC or equivalent public examinations.

Graduate Admission Requirements:

The minimum qualification for admission into a graduate program is:

- a. A relevant undergraduate degree from a recognized university with a GPA of 2.25 or above in a scale of 4.0
- b. A relevant Bachelor Degree with at least second divisions/ classes in all previous exams.

Admission on credit Transfer:

Students desiring to transfer their credits are expected to meet the admission requirements stated before for taking admission to any program of the university on credit transfer. Students intending to transfer to KYAU must submit syllabus and official transcripts from previously attended colleges and universities along with the admission applications. Failure to provide either will disqualify the applicants. Such students may be allowed to transfer credits if a minimum of 'B' / B+' grade is obtained in the respective course or if KYAU Equivalence Committee recommends such credit transfer. Admission test is required for transferring students.



Admission Cancellation:

Admission of any student may be cancelled by KYAU authority for the following reasons:

- If a student does not continue 3Bi-Semester consecutively;
- If a student does not pay his/her dues in time;
- If a student fails to provide necessary academic documents to the admission office;
- If a student takes part in any activity that goes against discipline or KYAU rules & regulations;
- If a student submits fake S.S.C/ H.S.C/ Degree or Equivalent Certificate/ Transcript at the time of admission his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.

Readmission:

KYAU students whose admission has been cancelled must submit application for readmission. If such students have attended other colleges and universities during their absence from KYAU they must submit official transcripts along with their applications. All such students will have to pay the Readmission fee.

Provisional Admission:

KYAU may provisionally accept applicants for admission who cannot produce official transcripts, certificates and other necessary documents at the time of admission. Required credentials must be submitted within the Bi-Semester of initial enrollment. Failure to submit the required papers would result in cancellation of the admission.
